Please take photos (either digital or printed) of the following, they will assist us in evaluating the condition and style of the heritage structure.

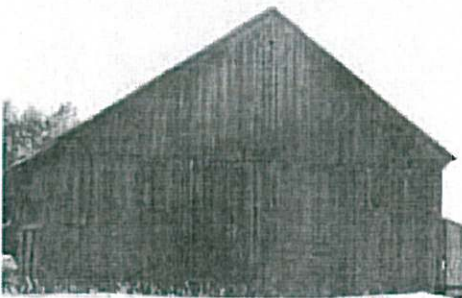
***From the Outside: to see the condition of the roof, walls and foundation***



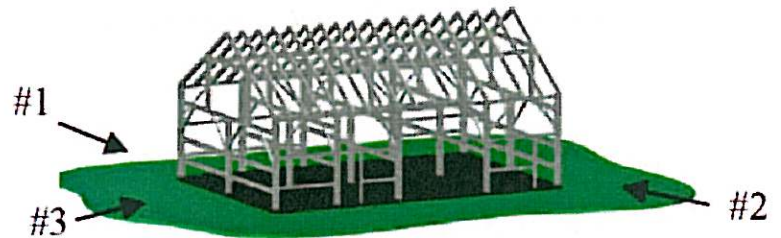
1) Corner of building showing the gable-end and one long side



2) Opposite corner of building showing the other gable-end and long side



3) Straight end on view of gable-end



**Size of building: Please provide us the following information:**

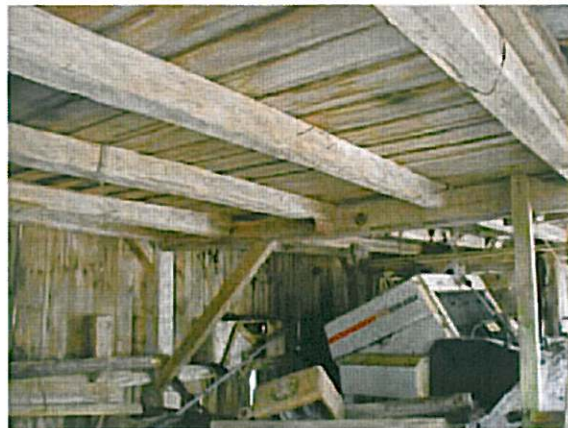
- a) Length
- b) Width
- c) Estimate of height of the side walls-sill to eve.
- d) Number of bents (see diagram)
- e) Size of the main posts (width)

Please look at the photos to see if they are visible and not too dark.  
Opening barn doors/ windows or shining a flashlight in some areas may also help.
